

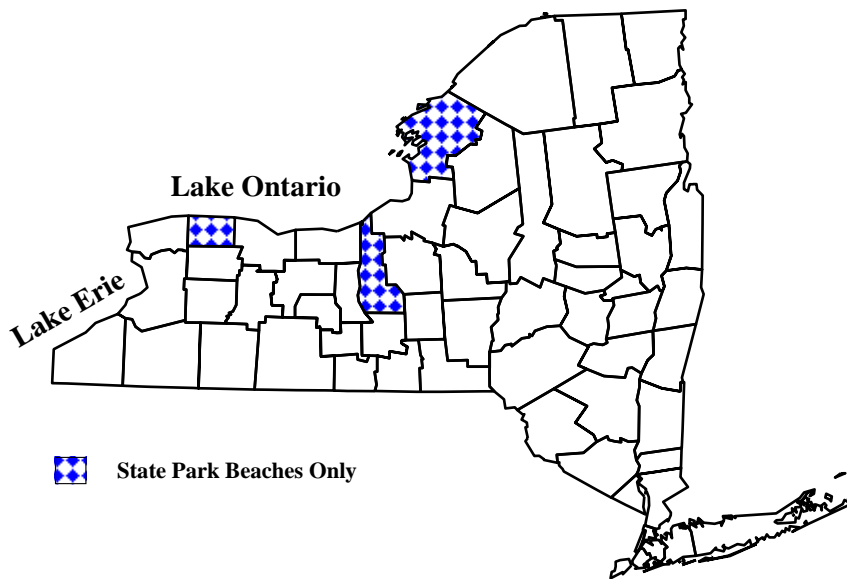

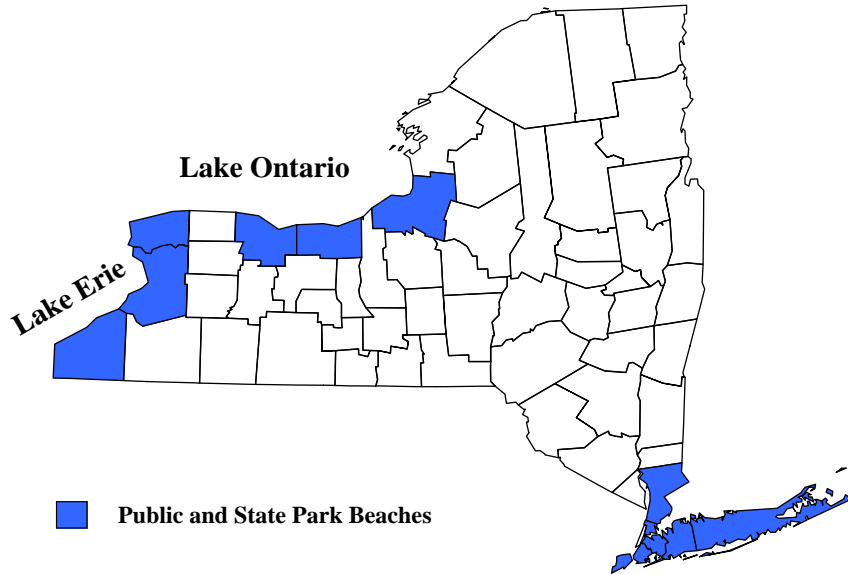

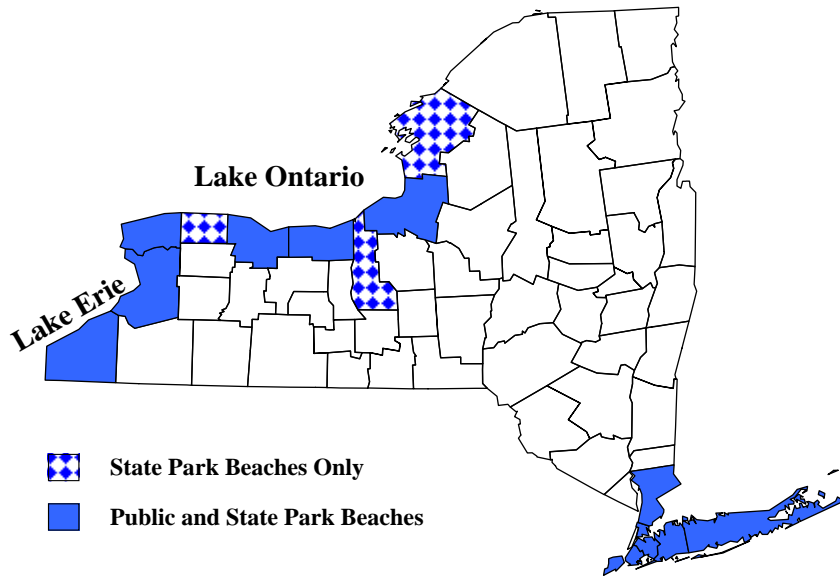
Coastal Beach Locations In New York State
