- ◆ Submitted abstracts should be limited to a maximum of 500 words
- ◆ The title should be placed at the top of the abstract in bold print, along with the name, title and affiliation of the author(s)
- ◆ Abstracts should be single-spaced in 12 point Times New Roman font
- ◆ Below the abstract, include the name of the intended presenter along with e-mail, mailing address and telephone number
- ◆ View and follow the Abstract Format Guide

The abstract must illustrate that the project is well developed, that general theory or experimental procedure have been established, and that some data have been collected and subjected to preliminary analysis. The conditions under which the data were obtained should be presented in conjunction with the methodology used.

Oral and poster presentations are invited. Oral presentations are limited to 20 minutes, discussion period inclusive. Eleven double sided display panels measuring 96" x 48" are available for poster presentations. Please create your posters within these dimensions and be aware that display panels are on a "first-come first-serve" basis. Oral and poster presentations by students are strongly encouraged. The CAWQ will confer the Philip H. Jones Award upon the student giving the best *oral* presentation.
