# KEYNOTE SPEAKER



**D**r. Gail Krantzberg is Professor and Director of the Centre for Engineering and Public Policy at McMaster University. Gail completed her M.Sc. and Ph.D. at the University of Toronto in the fields of ecology, biology, chemistry and toxicology, studying contaminant cycling in freshwaters and their ecological effects. She worked for the Ontario Ministry of Environment as Sediment Specialist, Coordinator of Great Lakes Programs, and Senior Policy Advisor on Great Lakes, and is a past president of the International Association of Great Lakes Research.

**D**r. Krantzberg was the Director of the Great Lakes Regional Office of the International Joint Commission from 2001 to 2005, after having served on the IJC's Water Quality Board, Council of Great Lakes Research Managers, Sediment Priority Action Committee and Indicators Implementation Task Force. The IJC's Regional Office plays a central role of overseeing binational progress in Great Lakes clean up and protection under the 1972 Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement. "In her presentation Dr. Krantzberg will be talking about the significant implications for the Great Lakes ecosystems as a result of the GLWQA Review."
